

Mandatory Health Screenings and Physicals

The district's health offices support your student's academic success by promoting health in the school setting. One way that we provide care for your student is by performing the health screenings as mandated by the State of New York.

During the school year, the following screenings will be required or completed at school:

Vision : Distance acuity for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, Grades 1,3,5,7, and 11.
Near vision acuity for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, Grades 1,3,5,7 and 11, and color perception screening for all new entrants.

Hearing : Screening for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, Grades 1,3,5,7 and 11.

Scoliosis : Scoliosis (spinal curvature) screening for Grades 5 and 7 for Girls and Grade 9 for Boys.

Physicals : A physical examination including Body Mass Index and Weight Status Category Information is required for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, Grades 1,3,5,7,9 and 11.

Dental : A dental certificate is requested for all newly entering students and students in Pre-K, Kindergarten, Grades 1,3,5,7,9 and 11.

A letter will be sent home if there are any findings on the screening done at school that may cause concern or need for medical follow-up. Please call your school's Health Office if you have any questions or concerns.
